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
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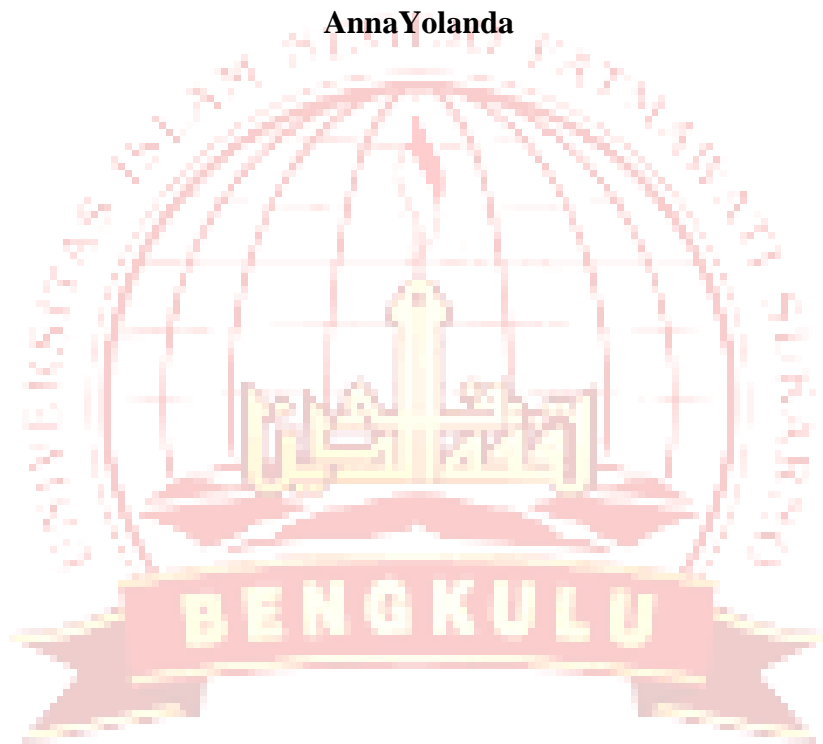

## **ABSTRACT**

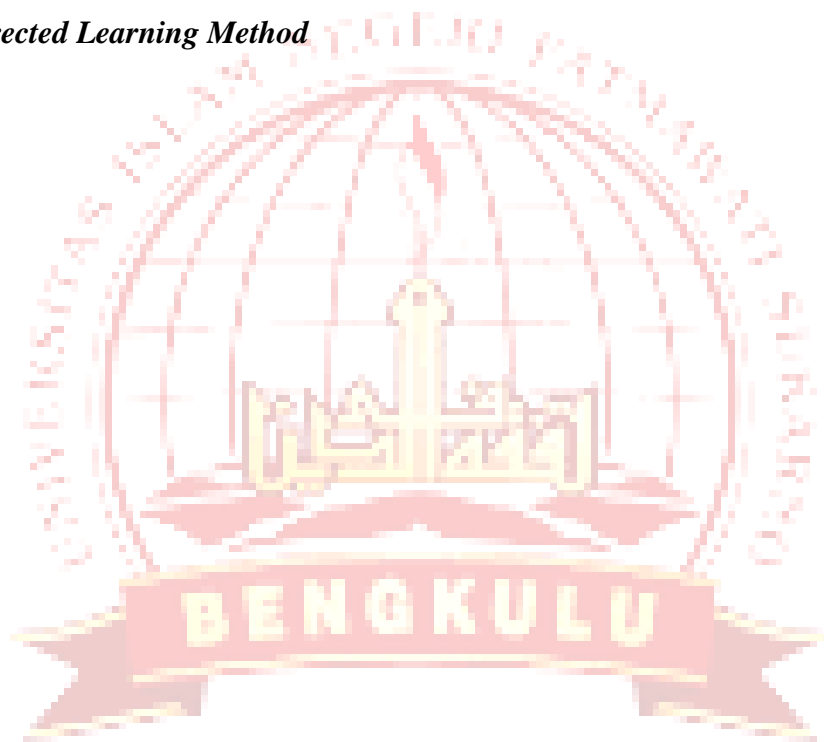

Difficulties in learning English, especially reading comprehension, occur due to a lack of initiative to develop independent reading learning by the students themselves. The purpose of this study is to find out the effect of the Self-Directed Learning on students' Reading Comprehension Achievement at Eleventh class students at SMAN 1 Bengkulu Tengah. Non-equivalent quasi experimental groups pretest-posttest design was used in this study . The population of this study was class XI SMAN 1 Bengkulu Tengah which consisted of 289 students. From the population 40 students were taken as a sample. There are two groups of 20 students each. XI MIPA 3 as the experimental class and XI MIPA 4 as the control class. Data was collected using multiple choice readings comprehension test. The experimental class was treated using a Self-Directed Learning method, while the control class used a traditional method. The results of the pre-test showed the average score of the experimental class was 55.95 and the control class was 58.55. The post-test results showed the average score of the experimental class was 82.65 and the control class was 74.50. The test results of the

hypothesis (sig.2-tailed) is 0.000 which is lower than 0.05. In conclusion, it can be concluded that the Self-Directed Learning Method Is 75% effective in developing students' reading comprehension achievement in class X1 of SMAN 1 Bengkulu Tengah which are more discipline and active in learning reading comprehension.

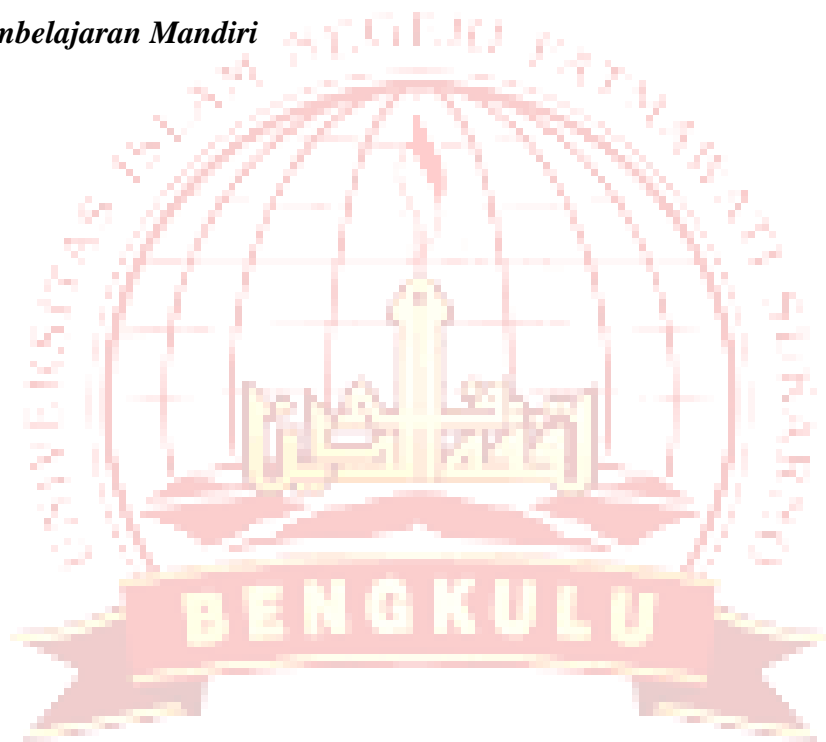

Kesulitan dalam belajar bahasa Inggris, khususnya pemahaman bacaan, terjadi karena kurangnya inisiatif untuk mengembangkan pembelajaran membaca mandiri oleh siswa itu sendiri. Tujuan dari penelitian ini adalah untuk mengetahui pengaruh Self-Directed Learning terhadap Prestasi Membaca Pemahaman siswa pada siswa kelas XI di SMAN 1 Bengkulu Tengah. Non-equivalent quasi eksperimen groups pretest-posttest design digunakan dalam penelitian ini. Populasi penelitian ini adalah siswa kelas XI SMAN 1 Bengkulu Tengah yang berjumlah 289 siswa. Dari populasi diambil 40 siswa sebagai sampel. Ada dua kelompok yang masing-masing terdiri dari 20 siswa. XI MIPA 3 sebagai kelas eksperimen dan XI MIPA 4 sebagai kelas kontrol. Data dikumpulkan dengan menggunakan tes pemahaman bacaan pilihan ganda. Kelas eksperimen diberi perlakuan menggunakan metode Self-Directed Learning, sedangkan kelas kontrol menggunakan metode tradisional. Hasil pre-test menunjukkan nilai rata-rata kelas eksperimen 55,95 dan kelas kontrol 58,55. Hasil post test menunjukkan nilai rata-rata kelas eksperimen 82,65 dan kelas kontrol 74.50. Hasil pengujian

hipotesis (sig.2-tailed) adalah 0,000 yang lebih rendah dari 0,05. Kesimpulannya, dapat disimpulkan bahwa Metode Self-Directed Learning 75% efektif dalam meningkatkan prestasi membaca pemahaman siswa kelas X1 SMAN 1 Bengkulu Tengah yang lebih disiplin dan aktif dalam pembelajaran membaca pemahaman.

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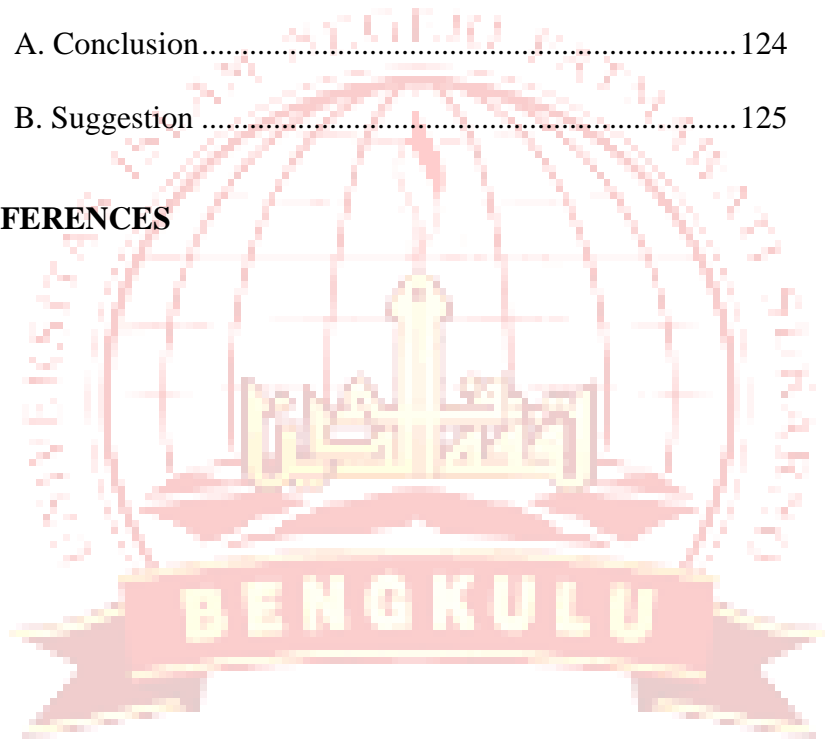
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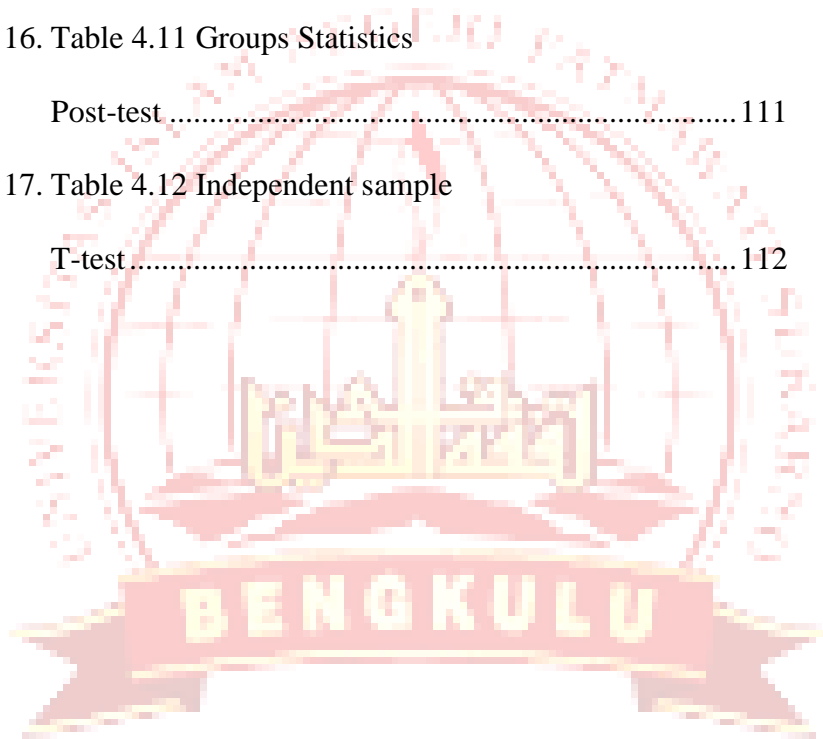
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
