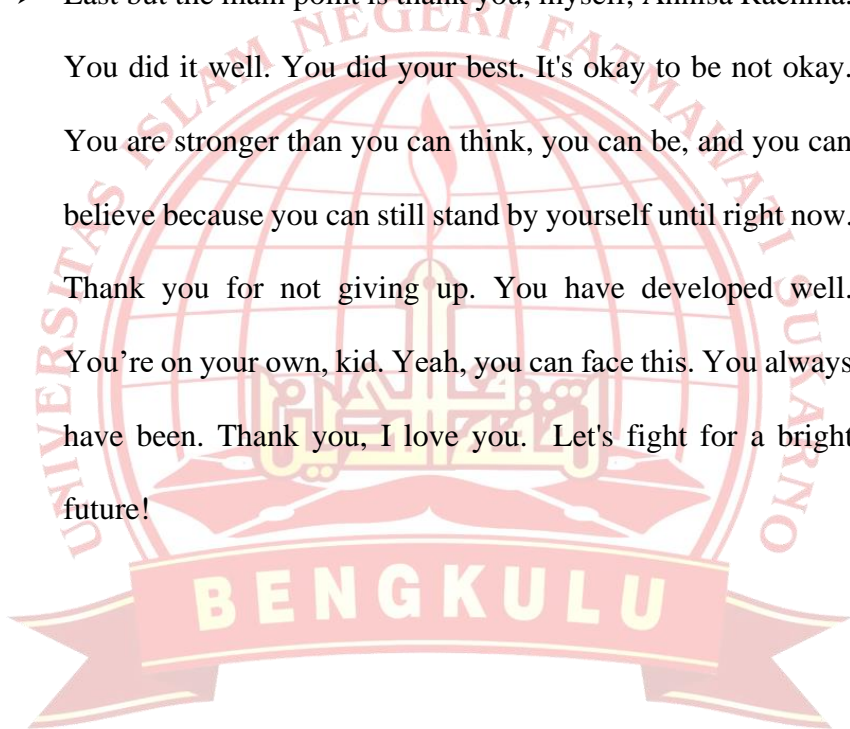

ABSTRACT

There are many grammatical errors that occur in speaking performance in English as a foreign language by EFL students. This study aimed to find out the types of grammatical errors and to investigate the factors that affect grammatical errors in speaking performance. The participants of this study were students in the sixth semester of the English Education Study Program at UIN Fatmawati Sukarno Bengkulu in the academic year 2022/2023. The purposive sampling technique was used in this study. This study was conducted by using descriptive qualitative research. The data were collected through speaking tests and interviews by recording. The data was words, phrases, and sentences uttered by the students. The grammatical errors in students' speaking performance are classified by using surface strategy taxonomy namely omission, addition, misformation, and misordering. The result showed 44,85% omission error, 32,92% misformation error, 20,58% addition error, and 1,65% misordering error. Next, based on the result of the interview, the main source of error is interlingual which is influenced by the mother tongue in their grammatical in using English as a foreign language. Then, the limited knowledge of foreign language which made them overgeneralization in using foreign language which is called intralingual transfer, and also context of learning and communication strategies are the source of errors.

Terdapat banyak kesalahan tata bahasa yang terjadi selama tampil berbicara yang dilakukan oleh mahasiswa. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mencari tahu jenis-jenis kesalahan tata bahasa dan menggali factor-faktor penyebab terjadinya kesalahan tata bahasa dalam performa berbicara. Adapun subjek penelitian ini merupakan mahasiswa semester enam Program Studi Tadris Bahasa Inggris UIN Fatmawati Sukarno Bengkulu tahun pelajaran 2022/2023. Penelitian ini menggunakan teknik sampling purposif. Penelitian ini juga menggunakan metode deskriptif kualitatif,. Data penelitian dikumpulkan melalui tes berbicara dan wawancara yang direkam. Data tersebut berupa kata, frasa, dan kalimat yang diucapkan oleh mahasiswa. Selanjutnya, data tersebut dianalisis berdasarkan pengelompokan kesalahan dari Dulay (1982 sebagaimana terdapat dalam Hikmah, 2020) yang disebut sebagai *Surface Strategy Taxonomy* dan penyebab kesalahan dari Brown (2004). Temuan dari penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa tipe kesalahan tata bahasa terjadi sebanyak 44,85% untuk kesalahan *omission*, 32,92%, kesalahan *misformation*, 20,58% kesalahan *addition*, dan 1,65% kesalahan *misordering*. Selanjutnya, berdasarkan temuan dari hasil wawancara, penyebab utama dari terjadinya kesalahan tata bahasa ini disebabkan oleh adanya pengaruh bahasa ibu (*interlingual*) yang mengakibatkan tatanan bahasa asing yang mengikuti bahasa ibu mereka tersebut. Selain itu, pengetahuan yang terbatas akan bahasa asing yang dipelajari menyebabkan terjadinya overgeneralisasi akan padanan kata yang ada (*intralingual*). Setelah itu, terdapat juga (*context of learning*)

dan (*communication strategies*) yang menjadi penyebab terjadinya kesalahan tata bahasa pada mahasiswa.

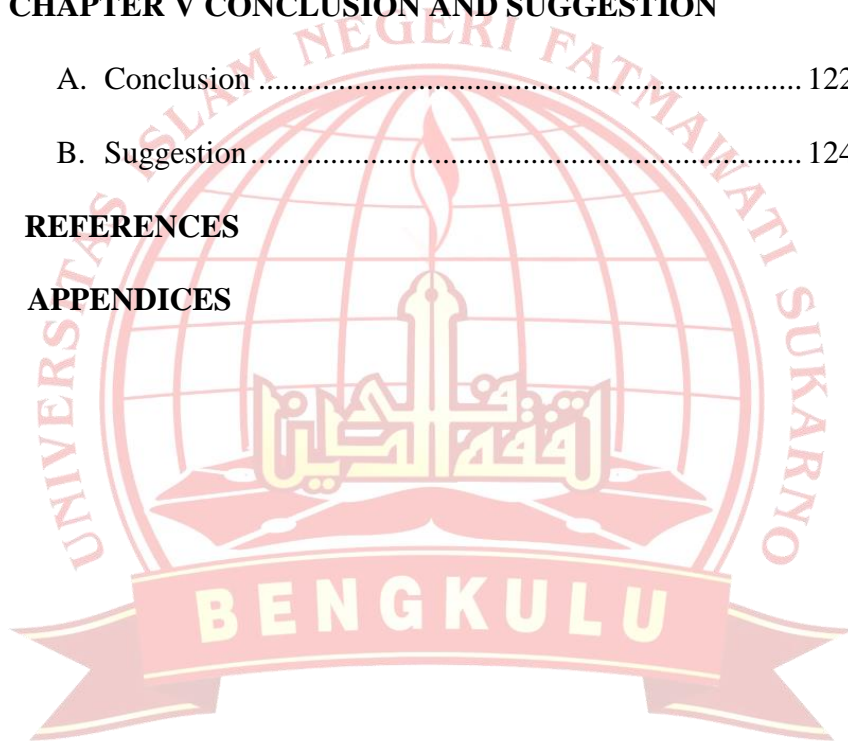
