## **ABSTRACT**

# ANDI LARIKI (2024): THE EFFECT OF DIGITAL STORYTELLING IN TOWARDS STUDENT'S SPEAKING ABILITY

(A Quasi-Experimental Study at 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Students of SMPN 14 Kota Bengkulu Academic year 2023/2024)

This study evaluates the impact of digital storytelling on students' speaking skills in English language learning. Using a quasi-experimental design with a quantitative approach, the research involved pre-tests and post-tests conducted on experimental and control groups over six sessions. The analysis results show that although there was an increase in the average scores in the experimental group, no significant difference was found between the pre-test and post-test (Sig. 2-tailed: pre-test = 0.651; post-test = 0.246). The calculated effect size (Cohen's d: pre-test = -0.061; post-test = 0.158) also indicates a very small impact. Therefore, digital storytelling does not significantly enhance students' speaking skills compared to traditional teaching methods, highlighting the need for additional strategies for greater effectiveness.

#### **ABSTRAK**

Penelitian ini mengevaluasi pengaruh digital storytelling terhadap keterampilan berbicara siswa dalam pembelajaran bahasa Inggris. Menggunakan desain kuasi-eksperimental dengan pendekatan kuantitatif, penelitian ini melibatkan pre-test dan post-test yang dilakukan pada kelompok eksperimen dan kontrol selama 6 sesi. Hasil analisis menunjukkan bahwa meskipun ada peningkatan rata-rata skor pada kelompok eksperimen, tidak ditemukan perbedaan signifikan antara pre-test dan post-test (Sig. 2-tailed: pre-test = 0,651; post-test = 0,246). Effect size yang dihitung (Cohen's d: pre-test = -0,061; post-test = 0,158) juga menunjukkan dampak yang sangat kecil. Dengan demikian, digital storytelling tidak memberikan peningkatan signifikan pada keterampilan berbicara siswa dibandingkan metode pengajaran tradisional, menunjukkan perlunya strategi tambahan untuk efektivitas yang lebih besar.
