CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

A. Background of the Study

English is a science that must be mastered today. Based on the Pre-observations made by the researcher in November 24 2023 the information obtained is that occurred during the teaching and learning process, they were unattractive teaching or teachers using traditional learning models or just use books as learning tools. Traditional education placed the teacher at the center of the classroom and gave the students a submissive role. Then in the learning process, the teacher also uses the lecturer method such as explaining the theory and concepts. So that they can find their own knowledge, attitudes and skills as a form of behavior change.
