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



ABSTRACT

This study examines students' perceptions of using ChatGPT for English language learning among fourth-semester Social Sciences students at UINFAS Bengkulu. The research addresses concerns regarding ChatGPT's role in academic contexts, including its impact on learning autonomy, critical thinking, and ethical usage. Employing a descriptive qualitative method within the UTAUT2 framework, data were collected through in-depth interviews, observations, and documentation involving ten participants selected via purposive sampling. Findings reveal that students perceive ChatGPT primarily as a transactional efficiency tool for vocabulary acquisition, translation, and assignment completion. Despite recognizing limitations such as output inaccuracy (reported by 90% of respondents) and risks to creativity (acknowledged by 70%), pragmatic adoption persists due to its immediacy and usability. Key factors influencing usage include performance expectancy, peer influence, and hedonic motivation, though institutional guidance remains absent. The study concludes that while ChatGPT democratizes access to learning support, unregulated use risks fostering passive dependency. Recommendations include developing AI-integrated pedagogical frameworks, promoting critical digital literacy, and establishing institutional policies to balance technological utility with academic integrity.

ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini mengkaji persepsi mahasiswa terhadap penggunaan ChatGPT untuk pembelajaran bahasa Inggris di kalangan mahasiswa semester IV Ilmu Sosial UINFAS Bengkulu. Studi ini menanggapi kekhawatiran mengenai peran ChatGPT dalam konteks akademik, termasuk dampaknya terhadap otonomi belajar, pemikiran kritis, dan penggunaan etis. Dengan metode kualitatif deskriptif dalam kerangka UTAUT2, data dikumpulkan melalui wawancara mendalam, observasi, dan dokumentasi yang melibatkan sepuluh partisipan terpilih melalui purposive sampling. Temuan mengungkapkan bahwa siswa memandang ChatGPT terutama sebagai alat efisiensi transaksional untuk pemerolehan kosakata, penerjemahan, dan penyelesaian tugas. Meski menyadari keterbatasan seperti ketidakakuratan output (dilaporkan 90% responden) dan risiko terhadap kreativitas (diakui 70%), adopsi pragmatis tetap terjadi karena kemudahan akses dan kegunaannya. Faktor kunci yang memengaruhi penggunaan mencakup harapan kinerja, pengaruh teman sebaya, dan motivasi hedonis, meskipun panduan institusional masih absen. Studi menyimpulkan bahwa meskipun ChatGPT mendemokratisasi akses dukungan belajar, penggunaan tanpa regulasi berisiko menumbuhkan ketergantungan pasif. Rekomendasi meliputi pengembangan kerangka pedagogis terintegrasi AI, promosi literasi digital kritis, dan penetapan kebijakan institusional untuk menyeimbangkan utilitas teknologi dengan integritas akademik.


