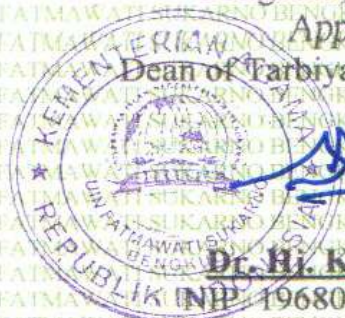

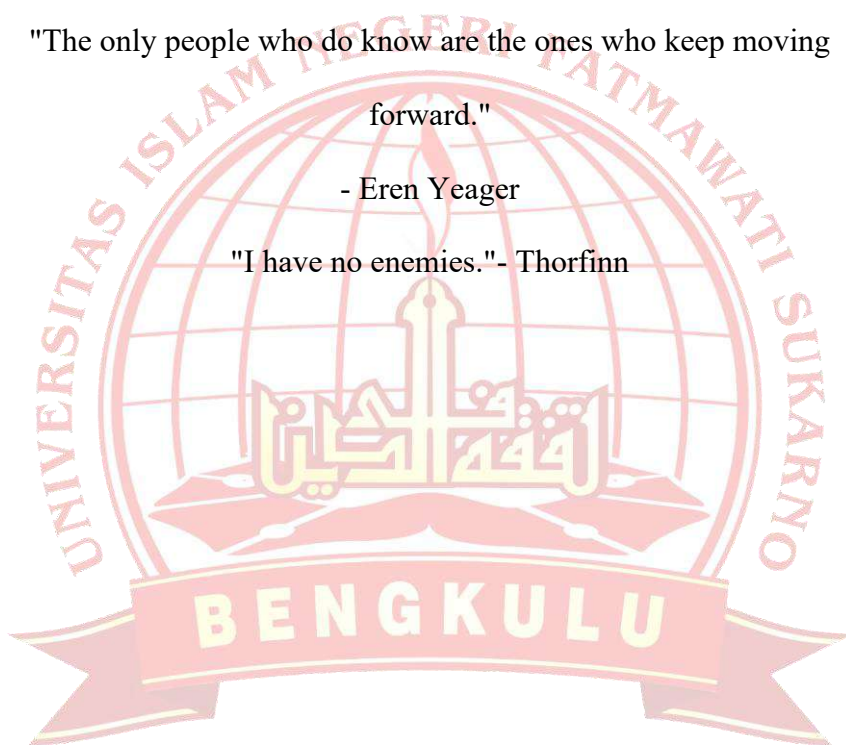

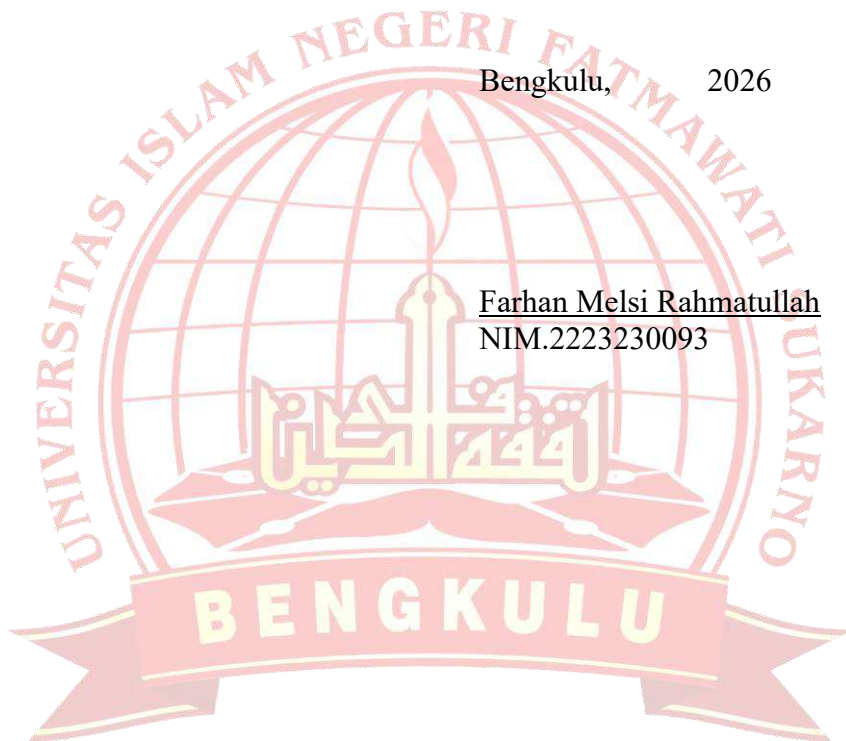

ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui pengaruh penggunaan lagu-lagu The 1975 terhadap penguasaan kosakata mahasiswa semester II angkatan 2025 di UIN Fatmawati Sukarno Bengkulu. Lagu-lagu The 1975 digunakan sebagai media pembelajaran karena mengandung kosakata yang beragam, menggunakan bahasa yang autentik, dan dapat meningkatkan motivasi belajar mahasiswa. Penelitian ini menggunakan pendekatan kuantitatif dengan metode kuasi-eksperimen. Sampel penelitian terdiri dari dua kelas, yaitu kelas 2C sebagai kelas eksperimen dan kelas 2B sebagai kelas kontrol, dengan masing-masing 16 mahasiswa. Instrumen yang digunakan adalah tes pilihan ganda dalam bentuk pre-test dan post-test untuk mengukur penguasaan kosakata mahasiswa. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan adanya peningkatan penguasaan kosakata setelah diberikan perlakuan. Nilai rata-rata kelas eksperimen meningkat dari 56.75 menjadi 91.25, sedangkan kelas kontrol meningkat dari 65.50 menjadi 78.06. Hasil tersebut menunjukkan bahwa penggunaan lagu-lagu The 1975 memberikan pengaruh yang signifikan terhadap penguasaan kosakata mahasiswa. Dengan demikian, lagu-lagu The 1975 terbukti efektif digunakan sebagai media pembelajaran untuk meningkatkan penguasaan kosakata mahasiswa.

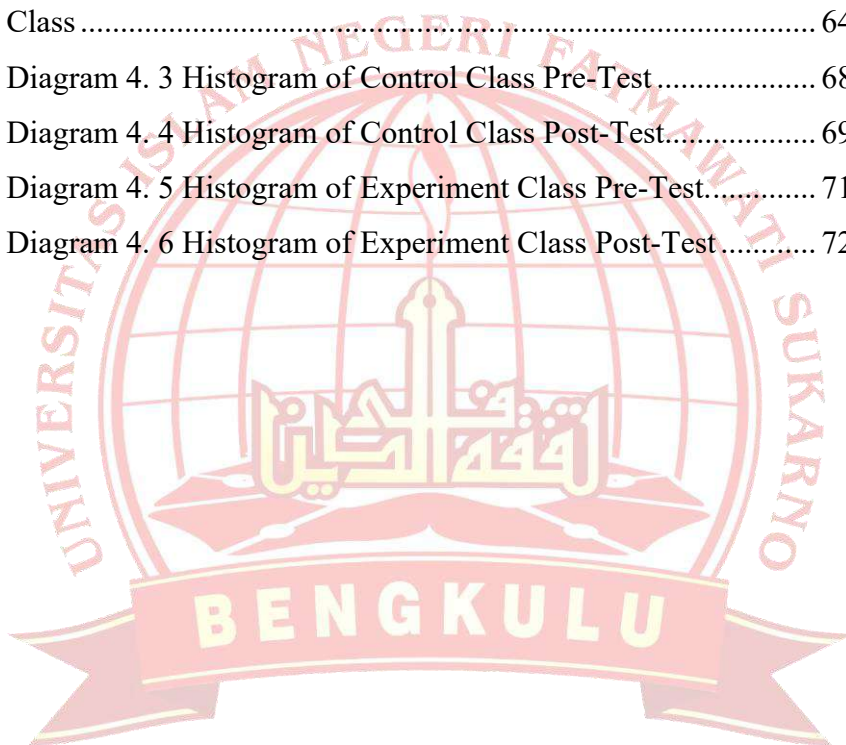

This research aimed to determine the influence of using The 1975 songs on the vocabulary mastery of second-semester students of the 2025 cohort at UIN Fatmawati Sukarno Bengkulu. The 1975 songs were used as a learning medium because they contain a variety of vocabulary, use authentic language, and can increase students' learning motivation. This research employed a quantitative approach with a quasi-experimental method. The sample consisted of two classes, namely Class 2C as the experimental class and Class 2B as the control class, with 16 students in each class. The instrument used was a multiple-choice test administered in the form of a pre-test and post-test to measure students' vocabulary mastery. The results showed an improvement in students' vocabulary mastery after the treatment. The average score of the experimental class increased from 56.75 to 91.25, while the control class increased from 65.50 to 78.06. These results indicated that the use of The 1975 songs had a significant influence on students' vocabulary mastery. Therefore, The 1975 songs were proven to be effective as a learning medium for improving students' vocabulary mastery.

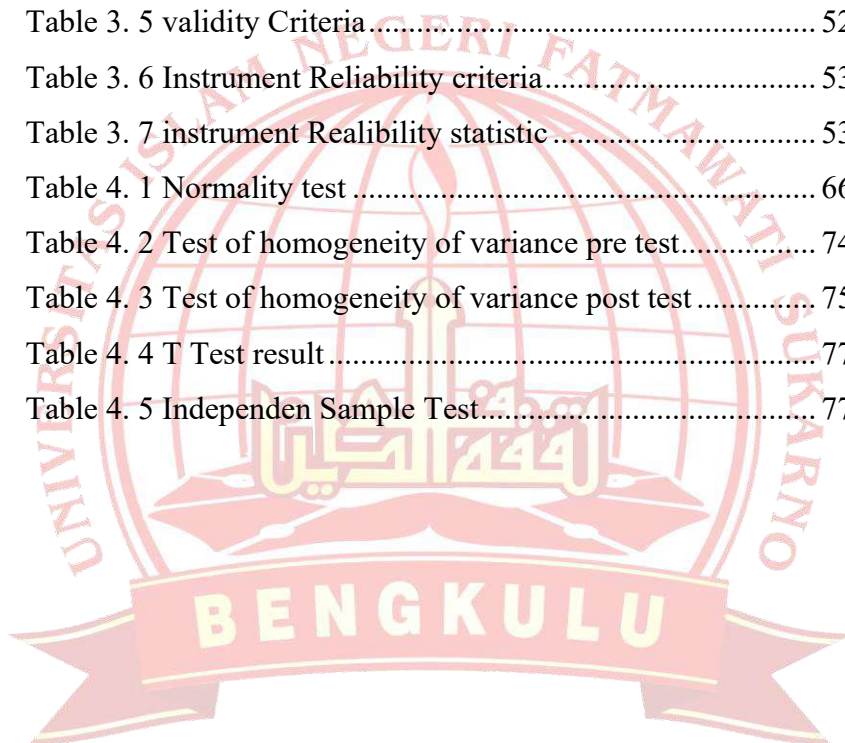
